II. The Pillar Of Unity And Permanency!

- **Matthew 19:6**
- Sunezeuxen is the past tense of the Greek verb suzeugnumi, which literally means “to tie together”, “to couple”, “to unite”, “to yoke together”
- That’s what happens when a man and a woman gets married!
- There must be unity in marriage – the two shall be one!
- To Christians, marriage is permanent
- When you get married...you’re stuck together...for better, for worse
- **Matthew 19:5**
- The parent/child relationship is temporary, but the husband/wife relationship is permanent
- *Everybody Loves Raymond* is a good example of a dysfunctional family!
- Profanity is one of the main symptoms of a dysfunctional and lack of a vital, saving relationship with Christ
- Profanity or foul language is an indication of a foul heart
- **Exodus 20:7, Matthew 12:33-37**
- It’s hard on mom and dad when the children grow up and get married. Sometimes mom and dad wan to keep “holding on.” We need to recognize the principle of permanency and the principle of unity within our children’s marriages. It is THEIR marriage!
- The only true unity is found in Christ!
- **John 8:24, James 2:19, Romans 10:10, Acts 2:38**
