I. Introduction

- What kind of witnesses would we be in a courtroom?
- Probably not good
- It's amazing that Christ entrusted His work to a group of human witnesses...the apostles and us today
- We are supposed to be the advanced men for Christ and make sure His message is carried to the world
- We are to be His witnesses – people who have experienced the power of Christ in their lives and who are willing to share that experience with others

II. Credible

III. Caring

- You are either a witness for Christ or a witness against Him
